

Join us under the stars for the 16th Annual Gimli Film Festival!

(Winnipeg, Manitoba; June 23, 2016) – Film fans and filmmakers will soon unite upon the shores of Lake Winnipeg for the 2016 Gimli Film Festival (GFF). Celebrating 16 years of film festival excellence, the annual five-day Festival will take place in Gimli, Manitoba from **July 20 to 24**.

The Gimli Film Festival has cultivated a reputation for bringing enlightening, thought-provoking, and entertaining cinema to Manitoba. The 2016 GFF features a phenomenal array of films and film series, including our Circumpolar film series, Icelandic film series, French Cinema series, Environmental film series, Social Justice film series, RBC Sunset Beach Screenings, and Kids' Cuts.

Making a debut at this year's festival are several first-time series—including a fascinating Ukrainian film series which delves into Canada's vibrant Ukrainian heritage; 'Next Wave Docs' - boundary-pushing films that experiment with documentary tradition, in collaboration with Winnipeg Underground Film Festival; an indigenous series called 'Coming Home: Indigenous films from around the world'; and the Reel Pride Series, a series of LGBTTQ* films in collaboration with Reel Pride Film Festival.

Overall, the 16th Annual GFF marks an exciting year of change and expansion for the Gimli Film Festival. 2016 will introduce the opening of a 6th film venue at GFF, a new lineup of stylish clothing and merchandise based on a delightful 2016 GFF design created by talented UK children's book illustrator Gillian Johnson; as well, a new executive director is captaining this year's festival—Rick Kemp.

In Kemp's words, increased sponsorship of this festival has allowed GFF to branch out and flourish. "The Gimli Film Festival is fueled by our sponsors' passion for film, culture and heritage," stated Kemp. "Their generous support not only provides a stage for Manitoba's filmmakers to showcase their talents, but a chance for all Manitobans to view otherwise inaccessible works of art."

RBC SUNSET BEACH SCREENINGS

Sitting in the sand, beneath a canopy of stars, film-goers will experience the magic of cinema on a one-of-a-kind 35-foot outdoor screen that rises up out of the waters of Lake Winnipeg. GFF's highly popular *RBC Sunset Beach Screenings* proudly presents six films at this year's festival, beginning at sunset every night.

WEDNESDAY: BOREALIS, by Sean Garrity (a made-in-Manitoba film)

Borealis is the emotionally-layered journey of an unemployed gambler who takes his estranged teenage daughter on a dangerous road trip up to Churchill, MB to show her the Northern Lights before her vision disorder renders her blind. This film is directed by Manitoba filmmaker Sean Garrity and written, produced and starring Jonas Chernick. (Chernick will be attending a 2nd indoor screening of Borealis on the Friday of GFF)

THURSDAY: ETERNAL SUNSHINE OF THE SPOTLESS MIND, by director Michel Gondry

Eternal Sunshine of the Spotless Mind is a romantic sci-fi comedy-drama about an estranged couple who have erased each other from their memories; this film explores the nature of memory and romantic love. (GFF is also thrilled to be screening the Canadian premiere of Gondry's latest film Microbe et Gasoil at GFF this year)

FRIDAY: RAIDERS! sweeps the beach with a double feature:

(10pm) RAIDERS OF THE LOST ARK In this classic adventure by Steven Spielberg, archaeologist and adventurer Indiana Jones is hired by the US government to find the Ark of the Covenant before the Nazis.

(I12am) RAIDERS! THE STORY OF THE GREATEST FAN FILM EVER MADE In 1982, three 11-year-old boys in Mississippi decided to film a shot-for-shot remake of their favorite blockbuster, Raiders of the Lost Ark. Over the course of seven summers, they risked their lives and their mother's house, finishing all but one scene. Years later, blood brothers reunite to shoot that scene they could never nail: the airplane sequence. Uproariously funny and achingly sweet, three grown men risk everything to achieve their childhood dream.

SATURDAY:

(10pm) DAVID BOWIE AND PRINCE SING-A-LONG Bring your beach towel and your singing voice to this unique event where the audience is invited to sing-a-long with their favorite David Bowie and Prince songs!

(12am) NUTS! is a documentary directed by Penny Lane, about Dr. John Romulus Brinkley, an eccentric genius who built an empire in Depression-era America with a goat testicle impotence cure and a million watt radio station. This Sundance Award-winning film traces Brinkley's rise from poverty and obscurity to the heights of celebrity, wealth and influence. NUTS is a form-bending documentary explores how "truths" can be invented by crafty storytellers, and what responsibility nonfiction filmmakers have to reveal the tricks of their craft.

<u>SUNDAY:</u> *THE GOONIES!* Sunday is kids' day at GFF, and the Sunday night beach screening of *The Goonies!* will wrap up the festival with a classic 80's adventure film. In order to save their home from foreclosure, a group of misfits set out to find a pirate's ancient treasure in this classic tale by director Richard Donner.

FILM SERIES EXTRAORDINAIRE!

Aaron Zeghers, GFF Artistic Director, is excited about the diversity and the quality of the 2016 film lineup, which includes many Manitoba, Canadian and World film premieres.

One highlight of particular note is the Canadian premiere of esteemed director Michel Gondry's latest film *Microbe et Gasoil*; Gondry is best-known for his film *Eternal Sunshine of the Spotless Mind*, which will screen under the stars on the Thursday night of this year's festival.

"I have been a fan of Michel Gondry's films for years, specifically his inventive, DIY aesthetics," noted Zeghers. "I'm very pumped that we're able to present the Canadian festival premiere of Gondry's latest film *Microbe et Gasoil*, with much help from our sponsors Alliance Francaise Manitoba and Cinemental!" Zeghers added that the writer of *Eternal Sunshine of the Spotless Mind*, Charlie Kaufmann, also has his latest stop-motion animated film *Anomalisa* screening in GFF this year.

Circumpolar Film Series - Cinema from the North
