If you’re a horror fan, several bone-chilling options are available tomorrow night:

- ***It Follows*** showing at 8:00pm at Lady of the Lake Theatre is a multi-layered horror film that focuses on the lost innocence of a carefree teenager who becomes infected by a fatal curse. More psychologically disturbing than gory, this film will leave you chilled and thinking.

- ***The Editor*** showing at 10:30pm is our Late Night “Pizza, Beer and a Movie” event in Johnson Hall. This slasher-gore film, produced by Winnipeg film collective Astron-6, centers on a once-prolific film editor who finds himself the prime suspect in a series of murders.

If ‘family fun’ is more your brand of entertainment, please join us on the beach for Kids Night on Thursday. Jim Henson’s ***Labyrinth*** is a mythical adventure about fifteen-year-old Sarah (Jennifer Connelly) who accidentally wishes away her baby half-brother, Toby, to the Goblin King Jareth (played by David Bowie). Experience their action-packed rescue mission under the stars on Gimli Beach!

**The RBC Beach Boardwalk** also begins Thursday night, offering a free treasure-trove of family-oriented games, music, and booths every single evening of the Festival. The fun starts at 7:30pm, and runs until 9:30pm.
